- 815** ☒ 1492 (Oct. 27th) letter from the three English ambassadors appointed for the treaty between England and Flanders made by Henry V of England and Philip of Burgundy. Written at Calais (then a British town) and addressed to "*Les honorables et Saiges Echevins et Conseil de la Ville de Grand*" three different wax seals on reverse, an interesting early item. - 816** ☒ 1582 and 1594 entires, both privately carried, scarce early items. £100-£120
- 817** ☒ 1633-1792 selection of mainly entires, incl. 1633 letter addressed to Sir Robert Heath (no postal markings), 1673 entire to London, bearing on reverse a fine "SE/29" Bishopmark, 1673 entire from Yarmouth to London, bearing on reverse a fine "DE/1" (without circular frame) Bishopmark, etc. (29 items). £500-£600

- 837 ☒ A large collection, mainly on Robertson's written up leaves, incl. 1840 E. bearing S.28 struck in error in red, overstruck by correct S.51 also in red, 1793 E. from Quebec to Norwich with S.31 in red, 1819 E. from Rotterdam to Batavia, bearing S.41 in red, also one in black on 1801 E. from London to Cape of Good Hope, 1807 E. to Scotland bearing S.43 in red, India Packet letters with 1819 E. from India to England bearing In.P.1 in red, 1815 E. to Madeira bearing on reverse P.P.W.S.L.1 in black, etc. (82 items). £1,500-£2,000
- 838 ☒ 1793 (June 10th) entire to London, bearing a good strike of the scarce "SHIP LRE" in red (Rob. S34). Photo on page 84. £150-£200
- 839 ☒ 1793 (Sept. 28th) entire from Ostende to Wimborne, bearing S.4 in red and S.5 in black, both struck on front. Interesting letter from a soldier serving in the British Army in Flanders. Photo on page 84. £150-£200
- 840 ☒ 1814 (Dec.15th) entire from Masulipatan to Edinburgh, bearing a fine strike of the scarce boxed "LONDON/SHIP LETTER/JU 23 1815" (Rob. S32 in red), partly overstruck by boxed "Add:/½" in black. £200-£250
- 841 ☒ 1821 (Jan. 22nd) entire from Paris, addressed to New Ross (Co. Wexford), most probably carried by a passenger on a ship bound for London. The sender obviously knew the procedure of dispatch by the London G.P.O. for Southern Ireland for it was correctly endorsed "by *Millford*". Bearing a straight line "A SHIP LETTER" in red (Rob. S35a) which is stated to one of only two recorded examples (both of the same correspondence), some cover faults. Which office applied this mark is still unknown. Ex Robertson. Photo. £350-£400
- 842 ☒ 1829 (Jan. 1st) entire letter with date line "Macquarie River Van Diemens Land" addressed to Settle, bearing circular framed "INDIA SOLDIER &/3/LONDON" in black (Rob. In.Sol.3) applied in error, on reverse has step-type "SHIP LETTER/GRAVESEND" (Rob. S.6), unusual. Photo. £120-£150

Provisional Specification. 24 June 1870.

I Robert Williams Nevins do hereby declare the nature of the said invention for "Driving and Steering Velocipedes" to be as follows.

- 1st I propose to place the seat low between the wheels of the bicycle on the Branch or Bearing Shaft made with a low bend for that purpose.
- 2nd I claim the use of bent handlebars the bent ends attached to the crank arms of the driving wheel the bends downwards and the other ends suspended by rods attached to the lower end of the dash board the upper end being fixed to the guide fork under the universal joint.
- 3rd I claim the use of driving handles fixed to the bent ends of the handlebars and pointing upwards or convenient positions for the hands and also in lieu thereof driving rods the lower ends attached to the crank arms the upper ends passing through eyes at the upper end of the guide fork.
- 4th I claim the use of driving rods attached to the crank arms and extending upwards and downwards the lower ends adjustable to the length of the legs containing pedals for the feet and the upper end for the use of the hands passing through eyes attached to the upper end of the guide fork.
- 5th I propose to make both wheels alike so that by reversing the crank shaft and handlebars and fixing them to the hind wheel it becomes the front and driving wheel the velocipede is then steered by means of a wheel or handle attached to the dashboard and co-ordinating under the seat and joined to the handle of the steering wheel.
- 6th I propose to make the steering fork to bend backwards and downwards by means of a spring joint so that it can be placed in an upright position and the velocipede converted into the ordinary kind for which purpose the branch fork is continued under the seat to allow of the hind wheel being moved forward.
- 7th The advantages claimed are greater ease and safety for the rider - the combination of the handle with the direct action principle and the facility with which the hands and feet are used alternately or both together thus economising pace and securing great speed.

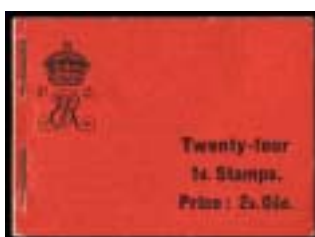

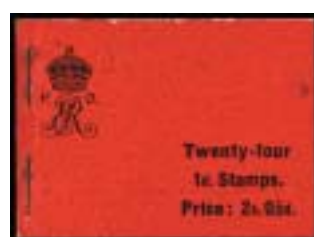
