

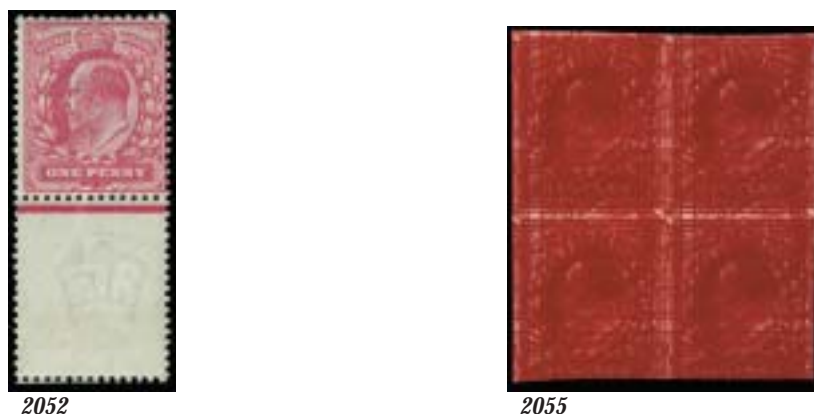
One Penny: 1906 De La Rue Colour Trials from Special Plate of 20 Electros



- 2047 P** 1d. blue-geranium imperforate colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, superb with full original gum. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£500-£600**
- 2048 P** 1d. cerise imperforate colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, a superb top marginal example with full original gum, a striking trial. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£500-£600**
- 2049 P** 1d. carmine-rose imperforate colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, horizontal bend at top not detracting from appearance, otherwise fine with large part original gum. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£400-£500**
- 2050 P** 1d. carmine-rose imperforate colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, slight creasing, otherwise fine with large part original gum. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£300-£350**



- 2051 P** 1d. blue-geranium perf. 14 colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, very fine with 'dry' gum. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£500-£600**
- 2052 P** 1d. carmine-red perf. 14 colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, a top lower marginal example showing additional Crown watermark in sheet margin, a couple of short or blunted perfs. at top, otherwise fine with full original gum (stamp unmounted). S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£350-£400**
- 2053 P** 1d. carmine-rose perf. 14 colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, exceptionally fine and fresh with almost full original gum. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£300-£350**
- 2054 P** 1d. carmine-lake perf. 14 colour trial on gummed paper watermarked Crown, perfs. clipped at left, otherwise fine. S.G. Spec. M5, cat. £1,200 (2005). Photo. **£150-£200**

- 2055** P 1d. carmine (quadruple impression, one inverted) imperforate plate proof block of four on thin white wove paper, unlisted by S.G. Photo. **£200-£250**

- 2056 ★ 田 1d. intense bright scarlet, a truly exceptional shade showing incredible intensity of colour, in a very fresh mint block of four, a few tiny printing ink offsets on gum and upper left stamp with tone spot caused by imbedded paper irregularity, otherwise fine with the lower pair unmounted. R.P.S. certificate (1954) states '*Harrison Printing, blood-red*' but we are firmly of the opinion that this is a De La Rue printing. Photo. £800-£1,000



- 2057 ★ 1d. deep blood-red plate 7, control "A" corner marginal strip of three, very fresh mint, left stamp creased, other two very fine unmounted, an exceptional example of this scarce shade. Photo. £350-£400

- 2058 ★ 1d. deep bright scarlet (intense shade) overprinted "ARMY/OFFICIAL", an unusual and distinct shade, fresh mint, a few small tone spots, otherwise fine. Clear R.P.S. certificate (1996). Photo. £80-£100
- 2059 1d., a mainly fine mint collection, carefully selected to show the wide range of the scarlet and carmine shades, with multiples incl. rose-carmine "B", "C4" and "J10" control strips, "I9" control blocks of four (2, one a lovely deep shade) and six, also a block of four in a most unusual carmine shade, etc. (83). (Photo internet). £200-£250
- 2060 ▲ 1d. in a very deep shade of deep bright scarlet, very fine used on small piece with "BRADFORD•ON•AVON/OC 14/04" double ring c.d.s. Photo. £60-£80

One Penny: 1911 Harrison Perf. 14

- 2061 ★ 1d., a mainly fine mint collection of the rose-red and rose-carmine shades, a fine range of mostly blocks and singles, also a block of four without watermark in brick-red from the plate 58 printing. (73). (Photo internet). £250-£300
- 2062 ★ 1d. rose-red, a much misperforated example, fine and fresh mint, also another example without gum and slightly toned. Photo. £100-£120



- 2063** ★ ㊤ 1d. aniline rose (F) plate 62 "A 11" (w) control block of six (3 x 2), a pale shade with a tinge of carmine, very fine and fresh mint, lower three stamps unmounted. Ex Beaumont. R.P.S. certificate (1959). S.G. 275a, Spec. M6(7), cat. £1,365+ (as singles). Photo. £500-£600



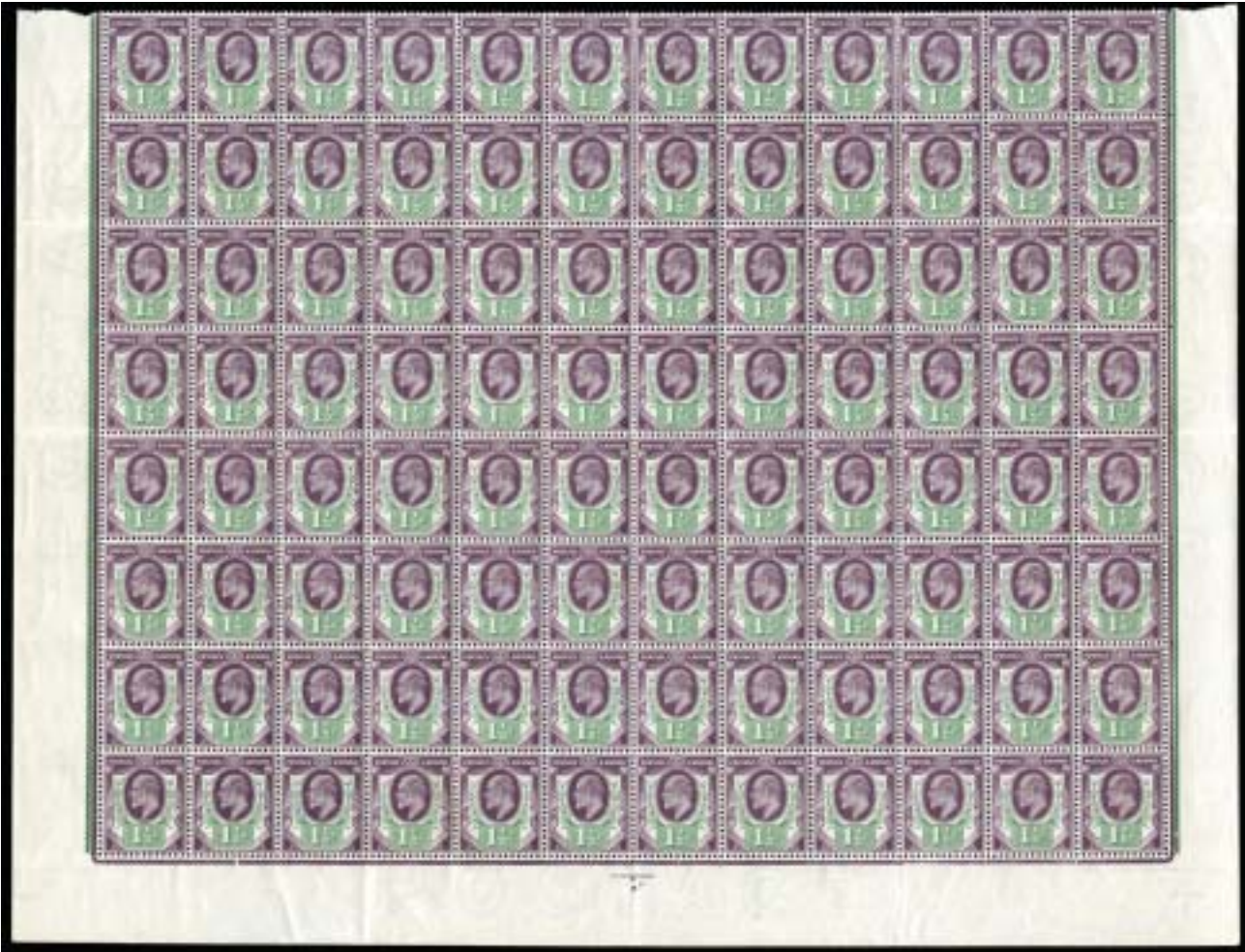
- 2064** ★ ㊤ 1d. aniline rose (F) plate 63 "A 11" (w) control block of four, a deep shade, very fine and fresh mint, lower stamps unmounted. S.G. 275a, Spec. M6(7), cat. £910+ (as singles). Photo. £350-£400



- 2065** ★ 1d. aniline pink (F), an exceptionally fresh lightly mounted mint "A 11" (w) control example, tiny corner perf. crease and minor bends, not detracting from appearance, otherwise fine and very scarce. S.G. 275, Spec. M6(8), cat. £650+. Photo. £200-£250

One Penny: 1911 Harrison Perf. 15 x 14

- 2066** ★ 1d., a mainly fine mint collection of the rose-red and rose-carmine shades, incl. rose-red blocks of four (3, one deep rose-red with the upper right stamp showing long second upright to "A" of "POSTAGE", pale rose-carmine "A 11" control strip with thick shiny gum, etc. (45). (Photo internet). £200-£250

One Penny Halfpenny

- 2067 ★ 1902–10 De La Rue 1½d., a mainly good to fine mint collection comprising ordinary paper blocks of nine (2), two vertical strips of three and nine singles; chalky paper blocks of twelve, eight, six and four (5) and eleven singles, showing a range of shades, mainly good to fine mint, about thirty five stamps unmounted, some of the chalky paper with tone spots or rubbing. (90). S.G. 221/224, Spec. M8 (1–2), M9(1–3). (Photo internet). £700-£800
- 2068 ★ 1911–13 Somerset House 1½d., a mainly good to fine mint collection of shades with blocks of twelve, nine, six, four (9) and singles (24), an excellent range, some showing fluorescence, mostly very fresh with about 33 stamps unmounted. (89). (Photo internet). £800-£1,000

One Penny Halfpenny Plating Pieces: 1902–10 De La Rue Ordinary Paper

- 2069 ☉ ☒ Head Plate 1, Duty Plate 5: 1½d. slate-purple and green, a very fresh unmounted mint block of 96 (12 x 8) comprising the lower eight rows of the sheet, perf. H1, showing cut under R20/2, R16/4 & 11 showing damage in tablet and R20/2 & 3 showing frame breaks at foot and right respectively, about 12 stamps with light creasing or gum creasing not detracting from this exceptional and probably unique multiple. S.G. 222, Spec. M8(2)/f/g, cat. £8,100+ (as singles). Photo. £2,500-£3,000



- 2070 ★ ☒ Head Plate 2, Duty Plate 4: 1½d. dull purple and green, perf. H1, a block of forty eight R7/1–10/12, the lower four rows of the upper pane including R10/2 retouch left of tablet and around large figure “1”, some creasing in sheet margins but the stamps mainly exceptionally fine and fresh mint (all but six unmounted). A very rare multiple. S.G. Spec. M8(1)/d. Photo. £1,500-£2,000
- 2071 ★ ☒ Head Plate 2, Duty Plate 4: 1½d. dull purple and green, SW corner marginal block of four, perf. H1, showing cut under R20/1 and with R19/1 showing the deformed leaf duty plate flaw (just a trifle rubbed by King’s face), mainly very fine and fresh mint, the stamps unmounted, upper right stamp with corner perf. just blunted. A rare positional multiple. S.G. Spec. M8(2)/e. Photo. £200-£250
- 2072 ★ ☒ Head Plate 2, Duty Plate 6: 1½d. dull purple and green, perf. H1, R4/7–10/12 lower marginal block of forty two (6 x 7) from upper pane, showing continuous purple rules and green rule with breaks every third stamp, very fresh mint, twenty eight stamps unmounted about ten of which have wrinkles or slight creases, some of the mounted stamps with imperfections, a scarce multiple of very fine appearance. S.G. 221, Spec M8(1), cat. £2,660 (as singles). Photo. £600-£800
- 2073 ★ ☒ Head Plate 2, Duty Plate 6: 1½d. slate-purple and green, perf. H1, R10/1–11/2 interpanneau marginal block of four from the left of the sheet, with R11/1 showing double serif to large “1” duty plate flaw, very fine and fresh mint (three stamps unmounted incl. variety), faint gum crease. A rare positional piece. S.G. Spec. M8(2)var. Photo. £250-£300
- 2074 ★ Head Plate 3, Duty Plate 6: 1½d. slate-purple and green, perf. H1, R11/1–12/1 NW corner vertical pair from lower pane, very fine and fresh mint (upper stamp unmounted), also 1½d. pale dull purple and green (chalky) NW corner pair R1/1–2, fine mint. S.G. Spec. M8(1) & M9(1). (Photo internet). £100-£120

2075 ☉ [R] **Head Plate 4, Duty Plate 6:** 1½d. slate-purple and bluish green on chalky, a superb mint interpanneau block of twenty four [R10/1-11/12], all but three stamps unmounted. S.G. 224, Spec. M9(2), cat. £1,580+ (as singles). Photo. £600-£700

2076 ★ [R] **Head Plate 4, Duty Plate 6:** 1½d. pale dull purple and green on chalky overprinted "30 PARAS" for use in British Levant (S.G. 16), a complete sheet of 240 (two panes of 120), mainly exceptionally fine and fresh mint, divided between 6th and 7th columns and rejoined with hinges, 198 stamps unmounted. S.G. Spec. M9(1), cat. £3,360+ (as singles). (Photo internet).. £800-£1,000



2077 ★ **Head Plate 4a, Duty Plate 6a:** 1½d. pale dull purple and green on chalky, perf. H1, complete bottom strip [R20/1-12] with nick and cut under R20/1 and dent under R20/2, R20/9 showing leaf and tablet repair, mainly fine mint, hinge reinforcement between stamps 5 and 6, five stamps unmounted (incl. variety), very scarce, also a SW corner block of four in deep slate-purple and bluish green but somewhat foxed on reverse (lovely deep shade and very fine appearance). S.G. Spec. M9(1/d & 3). Photo. £300-£350




2078 ★ [R] **Head Plate 5, Duty Plate 5:** 1½d. pale dull purple and green on chalky [R16/1-20/12] block of sixty (12 x 5), the complete lower five rows of the lower pane, perf. H1, divided in two vertically and rejoined with hinges, tiny head plate nick under R20/2, several showing constant head or duty plate flaws, an exceptional multiple, forty stamps unmounted (one with tiny tone spot on gum due to paper impurity). S.G. 223, Spec. M9(1), cat. £3,200+ (as singles). Photo. £1,200-£1,500



- 2079 ★ **Head Plate 6, Duty Plate 5:** 1½d. deep slate-purple and bluish-green on chalky [R9/1–10/2] SW corner block of four from upper pane showing square head plate corner dot in interpane margin, unique to this plate, also R10/12 corner single in pale dull purple and green (very pale shade) showing dot in opposite corner, the block with some foxing on gum but of superb appearance, the single with tiny natural gum flaws. (2 items). S.G. Spec. M9(1 & 3). Photo. £100-£120

- 2080 ★  **Head Plate 4b, Duty Plate 7:** 1½d. dull reddish purple and green [R1/1–10/6], block of sixty, the left half of the upper pane (right sheet) with coextensive rules, divided into four blocks of fifteen and rejoined with hinges, mainly fine and fresh mint, a few imperfections, thirty two stamps unmounted. S.G. Spec. M10(4), cat. £2,300+ (as singles, 2005). Photo. £600-£800
