Grosvenor Extensions Policy

- Requests for the possible sale of a lot 'on extension' must be made in writing not less than 48 hours before the commencement of the auction.
- The name of the proposed expert or expert committee must be provided to and approved by us before the sale. Some experts mark forged stamps and it is particularly important that permission for submission to these authorities be obtained from us beforehand.
- The reason for the extension request must be stated. Requests relating to condition only will not normally be approved.
- Extension requests will not be granted for any lot already accompanied by a recent certificate of authenticity, except by special permission.
- The sale of any lot identified in its description as having 'faults', 'defects' or 'imperfections' will not be cancelled in the event of these being specified individually on the issued certificate.
- Lots will be submitted directly to the nominated expert or expert committee by Grosvenor, unless otherwise agreed.

Railway Letter Stamps: Essays

Growing infringements of the Post Office monopoly created pressure that the Postmaster General moved to resolve by the proposal of an agreed Railway Letter Post, special stamps for which would be prepared with a face value of 3d. at a 1d. cost to the railway companies. De La Rue were instructed to prepare design proposals and a series of essays were prepared with differing inscriptions, these presented on Feb. 17, Apr. 14 and July 3 1890.

RAILWAY PHILATELIC GROUP

Railway Philatelic Group (RPG) members collect, research and publish information on anything with a rail-mail connection.

- lannananananananana New issues of railways on stamps from around the world are listed in our magazine, Railway Philately.
- Over 1,100 Travelling Post Office marks, plus subtypes, are listed in the RPG's catalogue.
- Railway Station Postmarks were used where • a post office was situated on a railway station; they had the word 'Station' in their postmark.
- Newspaper and Parcel stamps were used to show that the fee for carrying newspapers or parcels had been paid.
- Railway Letter Stamps were used for letters handed in at a railway station, which were then posted at, or collected from, a distant station. Most railways used a standard design and a number of preserved railways still issue these stamps today.
- Mail with Railway Sub-Office, or RSO, in the address would be dropped off directly from a railway travelling post office, rather than being taken to a distant main station then brought back again by road.
- So if you collect anything with a rail-mail connection, the ۲ RPG is for you.



Railway Letter Stamps of England & Wales

The Post Office's original proposal was abandoned due to legal complications but the need for an official arrangement with the railway companies remained. Articles of agreement and in November a subsequent basic stamp design were achieved, the official service for conveyance of letters coming into operation on Feb. 1 1891.




